ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

The Peckham Platform's Youth Platform collaborates with internationally recognised Swiss artist Marc Bauer. The 13–19 year-olds Youth Platform and Bauer have developed displays through a series of workshops exploring personal identity, gender politics and place.

Resulting from the workshops, Bauer and Youth Platform will create 2 large-scale multimedia artworks for public view located in the window of Peckham's Aylesham Centre and within Frieze London 2017. Opening as part of Peckham Festival 2017 this September, the Aylesham Centre installation featuring video and artworks by Youth Platform will be on show until November and is being delivered with generous multi year support from Paul Hamlyn's Explore & Test grant. In addition and inspired by his time with Youth Platform, Bauer will be presenting his own work at Frieze, the non-profit programme of new artist commissions at Frieze London (5 to 8 October 2017), supported by the LUMA Foundation.


